ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

Unusually, the Annual General Meeting will be held in June this year, so please put the following date in your diary. **TUESDAY 14**th **JUNE, 2016 at 7.00pm.**

FUTURE MANAGEMENT and STRATEGY of the CLUB

As a result of the recent upheavals, it became an opportune time to look at the future management and whole structure of the Club, particularly as the facilities are now 14 years old and beginning to show signs of wear. We are already facing expensive maintenance costs, but our overriding concern is to establish how we will be able to afford to replace the indoor carpet surface in perhaps three or four years time, which at today's cost would be about £120K.

The Committee have been in discussion with the LTA, and are considering three Options

- 1) Appoint a new Manager
- 2) Appoint TennisMad who have expressed a wish to manage the Club.
- 3) Appoint an outside operator experienced in managing UK clubs (such as GLL)

Following the previous experience with a Manager, the Committee have decided that it will not pursue Option 1), but invite TennisMad and GLL to make presentations to the Committee, with two or three other members of the Club attending, as part of a Working Party. It is the Committee's intention to report on these presentations to the AGM.

MEMBERSHIP and COURT RATES

The Committee has left the Subscriptions as they are, simply because these changes have to be approved at the AGM, but the Court Rates have been simplified, with marginal increases. We have recognised the need for income from Non Members and visitors, and as such we have reduced these rates, which were excessive last year and resulted in a loss of players and court income.

ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP

In order to attract many of those who left the Club, back to the fold, we are introducing a new Associate Membership for £10.00, and purchasing vouchers where the rate reduces the more you acquire. The vouchers are designed to appeal to novice players and may be used by their friends and family. The playing times are restricted to the Friday evening Club Session, and Sunday afternoons between 2.00pm and 4.00pm, provided the courts are available. The Vouchers are sold in books of 10, and have the advantage of giving the Club up front payments.

Unfortunately, many Members were disappointed to learn that the LTA had deemed them ineligible to enter the Wimbledon Ballot this year, for the following reasons. You must:

- Be an active "Affiliated" British Tennis Member (BTM)
- Be an Adult (18+) or Junior (9 17) BTM.
- Be a fully paid up member of a relevant venue(s) linked to your BTM record.
- Have OPTED IN to the BTM ballot with the LTA, by 19th February 2016.

In making the draw, we had to carefully check the LTA data for eligibility, as they would refuse to issue the tickets.

The number and general distribution of Wimbledon tickets we received this year, was very poor, and it is simply because our BTM members ignored a reminder by the LTA last October 2015, to **OPT IN** by the **19th February 2016**, and furthermore, they ignored a reminder by the Club a week later.

Remember, the number of tickets we get, are determined by the number of Affiliated BTM's we have, regardless of whether you want to go to Wimbledon or not. It is important that <u>everyone</u> should **OPT IN** at the end of the year, for the benefit of the membership as a whole.

CLUBHOUSE, CHANGING ROOMS and OUTSIDE COURTS

You will have noticed that the Clubhouse and Changing Rooms have been superbly decorated, and the outdoor courts and terrace tidied up, and we must thank Paul Butcher (in particular) for his long hours and hard work.
